What Is To Come?

This is a question we all want to know the answer to. But, though Yahweh holds His cards very close to His chest, they are prophesied. But there again, what might be the timing? I will give you an example—the coming of Yahshua. He came two thousand years ago, but even that was too early, and He left and went back.

So here we are, looking for His return. And we know that breach Christianity is not the answer. And we the second Remnant are to prepare His way. So how close are we to His return, and what is next for the Bride? And more specifically, what is next per the fulfilling work of the Bride, even the second Remnant Bride, and even that in Kenya Africa?

And digging even deeper, regarding Yahweh's ways, which are replicable, one of the most key figures in the entire Bible is Judas Iscariot. Why would I say this? Because his office remains open to this very day—Satan keeping it active for two thousand years after he entered into Judas. Thus, his office has remained alive and relevant all this time. And why would the Father do this? For several reasons, but for us today it is the scarlet thread that opportunes the true and much needed fulfillment. For example, Yahshua's first coming was a "failure," not producing the results we so desperately need. He went away, and His kingdom has been corrupted to this very day. Was it supposed to be corrupted? Yes. And the fact is, His true fulfilling kingdom would not come for two thousand years. And during that breach, the two thousand swine possessed by Satan, have all rushed down into the sea of death—kingdom men DIED! Why? For the same reason Christ died. It was not time for the fulfilling kingdom. As the one possessing the kingdom, Satan, questioned: "Have You come to torment us BEFORE THE TIME?"

Having noted this, let us now look carefully at the money box that Judas possessed, and obviously passed on to the devil. Satan told Yahshua concerning "all the kingdoms of the world": "I will give You all this domain and its glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I give it to whomever I wish" (Luke 4:5-6). But there is indeed a transfer that can and needs to happen, and it is tied specifically to Yahshua's money box. Just like the devil, Judas operated it for his own selfish reasons. And when Judas died, thereupon Satan had a right to the kingdom finances. And frankly, this is seen in churches everywhere. But the point is, Satan has to lose the money box, even as he has to stop taking kingdom man to death, as he has done for two thousand years.

Judas pilfered from the money box, and in the end betrayed the Son of God for thirty pieces of silver—the number associated with rulership. But today, not only does that office of the twelfth apostle have to come to an end for Satan, but it also must go back to a man! It started with a man, and it returns to a man. People think that Mathias received that office that Judas occupied, but not so. At the last supper, Satan entered into Judas and Yahshua told him: "What you are doing, do *it* quickly" (John 13:27). And he went out and betrayed the Son of God. That act was the beginning of the end of any hope for

God's pure kingdom, which would now be positioned in an ongoing state of corruption while Satan yet continued to rule. Satan entered into the office of the twelfth apostle, and that money box remained securely in his hands. So, what needs to happen? The office of the twelfth apostle needs to return to a man—the Elijah.

This is in fact the fulfillment of the true sign that causes belief as set forth in Exodus 4:1-5. There, the staff that Moses had in his hand was cast down to the ground, and thereupon became a serpent. Next, Yahweh told him to pick up the serpent by the tail, or literally by the "end," the end of Satan's time, and thereupon it turned back into a staff in the hands of a man. Thus we see:

Staff —> Serpent —> Staff

Or

Judas —> Satan —> Elijah

The first two of these acts have been completed. And now at the end of Satan's tenure, it is time for the office of Judas to return back to a man—the Elijah! And most significantly, this includes the money box! And now these finances are being used to restore and complete what began two thousand years ago, but is being cut short. The breach is over! The time of Satan's darkness is finished, and we the Bride must prepare the way for Immanuel, God with us! And, any gifts to the Bride are equal to giving them directly to Immanuel, to His moneybox, less the Judas betrayal.

Adding to this, let me share a most important testimony of a brother who is already living the life of banking on heaven. Or as Yahshua Himself said, "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal; for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Matthew 6:19-21).

And in like testimony, Yahshua told the rich young ruler: "One thing you still lack; sell all that you possess and distribute it to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me" (Luke 18:22). Possessing money is not one's answer for obtaining abundant life, but rather possessing that which is indeed of exceeding value. And today, this is all-the-more relevant, when men will choose to either ascend alive into heaven, or remain on this earth and abide in these earthly bodies for three or even six thousand years. Now, regarding that brother I mentioned, first and foremost he was the first person who arose to evidence that he was one of the latter-rain twelve apostles. And what's most unique is that he never fit into Christianity. He is a unique individual, and I knew this within two seconds of meeting him. And he fears God, and does not want to miss the mark and thereby be disqualified. And certainly there is nothing wrong with having a healthy portion of that caution. And let me give you an example of that quality, and would say that it would have been most beneficial to the rich young ruler.

This brother has a very good job, and has been there for twenty-seven years. And during that time he has invested in stocks, and has come out quite well. But there is one thing that is more valuable and compelling to him, and that is to fear God and seek to know and understand Him. This is one of the reasons He found the Bride to be most revealing and compelling. And frankly, there is nothing more important to him than to walk circumspectly and be faithful in giving all to the Father. And this has put him in a most significant place.

Contrary to Judas, he fears God, and wants to obey. And contrary to the rich young ruler, he wants to be counted faithful. So frankly, most recently he has given up all of his stocks and bonds for the work of the Bride, and goes another step as well. The foolish rich man in second Remnant Luke 12 chose to build larger barns and store all of his grain. Then he said, "This is what I will do: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods." And he sought to eat, drink, and be merry. But in so doing his soul was required of him!

Today, this is the choice that people will have leading up to the coming of Immanuel, and some will repeat the fate of the first Remnant couple, Ananias and Sapphira. They held onto their wealth, lied about it, and God smote them and they died.

This is the fear that this dear Bride brother passionately has—not the loss of money, but that holding onto it would disqualify him from ascending alive. And as I write this, I am in his home of twenty years, preparing it to go on the market in just days. And, the profit from this sell will go entirely to the Bride—providing a rather significant sum. And this is even above what he has already given in stocks.

And there is something else that is most significant here. Judas was the twelfth apostle, and loved and sought money—betraying the Son of God for it. Today, this first apostle of the latter twelve has done just the opposite. He is giving all to the Father, willing to hold back nothing. And with this contrasting example of this latter-day apostle, others will need to follow, just as they performed in the first Remnant. "And the congregation of those who believed were of one heart and soul; and not one of *them* claimed that anything belonging to him was his own, but all things were common property to them" (Acts 4:32).

So most noteworthy, we find the stark contrast between the failure of the first twelfth apostle, Judas, as well as the breach of Satan for two thousand years. But today there is the stark and even fearful obedience of the first apostle at the coming of Immanuel. Yahweh flips things to make them clean, and He has certainly done so with these two apostles—the former and the latter. And I would add that there has been yet another apostle who has equally sacrificed, giving up all he had for the future and even the present—his most notably for the Bride Hall, and up to this day. And I trust that these two gentlemen are just the beginning.

May Yahweh fulfill His word and His work in this seventh day of mankind.
