GARY REPORT

Africa Trip Update

I received an email from a Bride brother who asked:

While you're in Africa, will there be anyone there at your Salem address to collect your mail and deposit checks if that's what needs to be done?

Do you have a timeline of how long you will be in Africa?

And do you have funds to cover this timeline?

I very much appreciate this brother's enquiry, because it takes far more than me and the two Bride brothers to make an impact there. The reality is that it equally requires your support, your participation, in upholding this work financially. I address his questions, and more, in the following email that I sent to him, but with slight editing so that it speaks to all of you.

"Brother,

"Let me elaborate on the Africa trip, if I may. To begin with, many times in life I have simply obeyed the Father when I knew it was a risk and could fail. When I got out of college I went to work for the Texas Air Control Board, in the Home Office in the compliance division. After almost seven years I knew it was time that I leave, and I quit, not having a job. God then called me into the pastorate, and after a sovereign delay of a year we moved to Dallas. In time I went into full time ministry, and the Father provided. We eventually moved to the ranch we had built for the needy, and it was there that He began revealing the Bride and told me to move to Washington State. I obeyed, and one week before we drove off of the property, a door opened that provided a place for us to stay. After seven months that door closed and amazingly we found a wonderful place in the country where we/I lived for ten years. Then, Yahweh led me to move to Salem, Missouri, and I knew I was taking a great risk in doing so, but obeyed. And it too worked out.

"My point in telling you this is that many times the Father has led me in a way where if He was not in it, I would have failed and even come to ruin to different degrees. But I obeyed and He has always been there. My/our trip back to Africa is yet another one of these cases, though more risky than the others with all the murders and attacks. At this point, financially, there is no way I have the funds to do all that needs to be done. They expect that at these meetings we provide food and chairs and such, but I have told Caleb that is not even possible. The food is something that has been done in the past when Caleb was out and about traveling from place to place. We have already provided the funds for the first two meeting facilities, and I have told Caleb that we will open the invitation to anyone who wants to come—pastors or not. Right now we are having a ten by ten banner made that will be raised up at the facility beforehand to let

people know about the meeting. Caleb suggested this and offered that it read: "Want to know more about the Kingdom Of Heaven? Attend the Bride Truth seminar with Gary Naler."

"Right now we have about a thousand dollars in the bank, but I know that will not last long. Caleb and Walter keep getting requests to meet with pastors and bishops at different locations to plan for me to come, plus there are always other needs. And I can tell you this, Africans are unique in that they do not like to make plans over the phone. There is something about them that they have to plan face to face, and that means traveling expenses, which I have required that they be shared. And there are other expenses, such as Caleb moving into that new large home that was given to him by Elijah. The electricity had to be hooked up and some more wiring was needed to install the security system. That cost another \$300.

"But I know Yahweh has called us to Africa at this time, and as I expressed in the opening paragraph, it is not the first time I have been called to obey despite my vulnerability and need for His provision. Your recent gifts have already evidenced His provision and affirmation in this trip, and I continue to walk towards the goal of obedience and trust Him to make the provision and the way clear as to where we are to go. We have suffered many challenges in Africa in getting where we are now, and the tide seems to have changed already and is looking better. Our Society registration is supposed to be ready on November 30, and things are coming together for the meetings. And again, Caleb was blessed with a nice house, and that provided by none other than by a man named Elijah! I fully trust Satan will be defeated and even fall backwards himself. We are showing up with the hope to see Yahweh move. And, I clearly see what my message is to be and how it unfolds. It its a very solid and compelling message! Blessed be Yahweh.

"So to answer your question regarding funds to cover the timeline, I go one day at a time. When we get there on December 3, I begin teaching on the fourth and fifth. I trust the provision will be made for hotels and meals, and I know Jim and possibly Tommy are covering theirs. And hopefully Caleb and Walter will have places to stay. I'm sure that will work out, but I cannot rely on any provision for such coming from Africa. One thing I learned when I was there three years ago, Africa IS NOT America, and you cannot expect them to have the funds to do what needs to be done. It is DEFINITELY the cursed continent that bears Satan's image. So, these are our opening two days, and after that is another two-day teaching in Nairobi. Then Mombasa and on and on and

"Now, having said this, there is one thing that can affect every bit of it, and that is a move of Yahweh's Spirit. THAT will get everybody's attention and change the dynamics considerably! But, that is in the Father's hands. Even so, this is my second time back to Africa, my second-bird work that I trust ascends alive. But here again, this is all in the Father's hands, and we go, trusting in Him. And as I noted at the outset here, this is one of many times in my life where I have to go, trusting wholly in Him.

"If I may, I am reminded of another time the Father led me in this way. By His leading, I packed up the family and headed out to take a vacation wherever He led me. We went to Creed, Colorado, and had no reservations or warm bedding—and we

had young children. At the end of the day, we were facing a cold night; but at the very end of our pursuits there was a beautiful cabin available from a cancelation and they dropped the price considerably for us. It was the best vacation we ever had, and the Father told me to go out and He would lead me. Even now I go to Africa with the same hope and trust. And in that Colorado trip, at the headwaters of the Rio Grand, we caught our limit of trout on a daily basis, and in a very short time. Like my experience of fishing "on the other side," I pray it is our time for a miracle catch in Africa and beyond! You can read about that "on the other side" experience here.

"So you can see that I have great hope for the trip that is before us. You have already added some hope with your gifts for a projector and Tommy's ticket. I do believe that was the will of the Father. And regarding a timeline, Tommy is scheduled to be there one week, and Jim and I have flights that fly us back at the end of December. But that is based on Jim's leave from his work. He took off the entire month of December. But if the Spirit moves, it will be as it is written, "and time will be no more," or "there will be delay no longer" (Revelation 10:6). God will cut time short from three to two, and He will move on the earth in a way that has never before been seen! From there, the Spirit takes over and the way for Immanuel is prepared and the heavens and the earth are shaken! This is our hope; and if this happens, He will lead and doors will open. And frankly, there are already many open doors all across the vast continent of Africa.

"Any funding leading up to or at the time of our trip would be GREATLY appreciated. I can keep you informed of our financial status as things unfold, but gratefully we presently have about \$1,000 [of course which is minimal for a project as large as this]. But I have no idea what funds will be needed between now and December 1, or what other funds might come in. And the financial needs after that are to be seen. We truly walk by faith and trust wholly in the Father. As has been my life experience many times, we will walk forward and look to Him to perform His work and provide the way.

"Regarding someone being here in Salem to collect my mail and deposit checks, there is no one. We have talked about Zelle, and the other is PayPal.

"I hope this answers your questions and gives you an idea of where I am in this and what is set before us. And even as our travel date draws closer, I will undoubtedly know more, including what the first two meetings are looking like. I am certainly looking forward to going, and know clearly what I will be sharing. I am also taking some recording equipment with me and hope to put together a video of a meeting, or at least part of it or simply a "news" report. And I hope we have lots of good news!

"Thank you for your concern, interest, and help. It is a hopeful encouragement to me, and what you have already done in your provision is just that as well. I/we do indeed look to the Father to equip us for every good work and word, and may He be praised and establish His bride for His Son. Feel free to ask any questions, and I hope this email is helpful.

"To God be the glory."
